

General information

Flutriafol is a fungicide, control of a broad spectrum of leaf and ear diseases in cereals, at 125 g a.i./ha. Also used in non-mercurial seed treatment formulations to control the major soil-borne and seed-borne diseases of cereals.

Direction for use

Check the drop carefully and regularly. Spray only if there is sufficient time in the season for the rust to develop to a level on the variety in question when it will cause significant yield loss.

Personal protective equipment

Eye: Safety glasses with side shields, Chemical goggles.

Hands/feet: Wear chemical protective gloves, eg. PVC. Wear safety footwear or safety gumboots, eg. Rubber. Suitability and durability of glove type is dependent on usage.

Environment hazards

Flutriafol is lowly toxic to honeybees if used as a foliar application, especially during flowering, but is not considered a hazard to bees when used as a seed treatment.

Storage and Disposal

Store in the original container in a dry, cool, ventilated Locked area .Do not store in prolonged sunlight .Do not store with food, seed, or animal

feedstuff.

Pesticide Disposal: Soil is a suitable absorbent, especially soils high in clay. Soil can be used to form bunds to contain spillage.

Container Disposal: Triple or preferably pressure rinse containers before disposal. Add rinsings to spray tank. If recycling, replace cap and return clean containers to recycler or designated collection point. If not recycling, break, crush or puncture and bury empty containers in a local authority landfill.

First Aid

Swallowed: Refer for medical attention, where possible, without delay. For advice, contact a Poisons Information Centre or a doctor.

Eye: Immediately hold eyelids apart and flush the eye continuously with running water. Ensure complete irrigation of the eye by keeping eyelids apart and away from eye and moving the eyelids by occasionally lifting the upper and lower lids.

Skin: flush skin and hair with running water. Seek medical attention in event of irritation.

Inhaled: Move person to fresh air and keep at rest until recovered.
